Event Description: Join the Suncoast Sandpipers in a 5 or 10 kilometer (3.1 or 6.2 mile) go-at-your-own pace walk in historic Oldsmar as the city celebrates its 49th Oldsmar Day & Nights Festival. 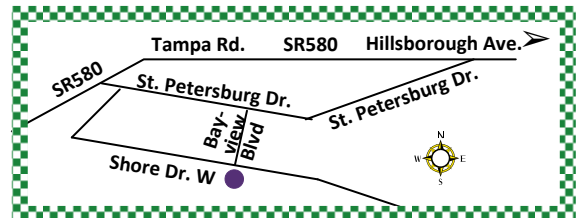

Start Location & Times: Festival Tent, R.E. Olds Park. 107 Shore Dr. W. Start walk anytime between 8-9 a.m. Finish by noon.

Trail Description: Enjoy a flat, easy (rated 1) walk in charming, historic Oldsmar, nestled on beautiful Tampa Bay. The walk includes a tour of historical homes built during the early 20th century when Ransom Eli Olds, inventor of the Oldsmobile and REO, was developing the area into a bustling community.

Directions: From US 19, take SR 580 (Main St) and go east (towards Oldsmar/Tampa) about 4 miles to St. Petersburg Dr. Right to S. Bayview Blvd. Right to Shore Dr. and Olds Park. From Tampa, head west on Sr. 580/Hillsborough Ave. to St. Petersburg Dr. Left to Bayview Blvd. Left to Shore Dr. and Olds Park.



Parking: Because of the Festival, parking is available on the streets only.

Refreshments: The club will have water and candy at the start and checkpoint (carrying water is also recommended). After the walk, enjoy the food and beverages offered by Oldsmar Day and Nights festival vendors.

Fees & Preregistration: The basic walk fee is \$2; free for kids 12 and under. Volkssport credit is \$1. Please fill out registration form, check applicable columns, and send with payment to: Suncoast Sandpipers, PO Box 2514 Largo FL 33779 by Mar 22. While preregistration is not necessary, the City of Oldsmar is giving the first 30 registered participants a commemorative pin depicting a 1904 Roundabout.
